COMPETENCY BASED ASSESSMENT-2021

[Under Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection)(Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 and Amendment Rules 2020]

As directed by Government of Rajasthan vide Circular no. F.2(26)DME/Gen./ PCPNDT/2014/ Part-1/1095 dated 01.03.2021, the Competency Based Evaluation Assessment Examination - 2021, will be conducted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, in accordance to the guidelines given in Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection)(Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 and Amendment Rules 2020, for the candidates who are conducting ultrasound procedures in a Genetic Clinic or Ultrasound Clinic or Imaging Centre on basis of one year experience or Six Months Training before 9th January 2014 (i.e Before the publication of Notification for Prohibition of Sex Selection)(Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in Gazette of India and also for those candidates who have completed Six Months Training in "Fundamentals in Abdomino-Pelvic Ultrasonography: Level one for MBBS Doctors" after due selection as per the criteria's laid down in the above mentioned gazette dated 9th January 2014 from Year 2014 and onwards.

Eligibility:

Category-1: Existing Registered Medical Practitioners who are conducting ultrasound procedures in a Genetic Clinic or Ultrasound Clinic or Imaging Centre on basis of one year experience or Six Months Training from before 9th January 2014(i.e Before the publication of Notification for Prohibition of Sex Selection)(Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare in Gazette of India and whose names have been forwarded by state PCPNDT Cell, Directorate of Medical and Health Services, Govt. of Rajasthan.

Category-2 : Candidates who have completed Six Months Training in "Fundamentals in Abdomino-Pelvic Ultrasonography: Level one for MBBS Doctors" after due selection as per the criteria's laid down in the above mentioned gazette dated 9th January 2014 from Year 2014 and onwards.

* The dates of Second/Third round of examination will be announced in due course of time.

Important Note: The Existing Registered Medical Practitioners (Category-1 of eligibility) will be given three attempts to clear the Competency Based Assessment.

There will be three rounds of Examination (Theory and Practical) for Competency Based Assessment. The first examination will be held in the month of November 2021. The Second round of Examination will be held in the month of December/January and the Third & Final round will be in the month of March/April 2022.

"If a medical practitioner fails to clear the competency based examination after three attempts, he shall undertake the complete six months training, as provided under the rules, for the purpose of renewal of Registration."

Fee for the Examination: The fee for examination will be Rupees Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Sixty (Rs. 9960/-) for each examination and will be deposited online.

Syllabus of the Examination: The Syllabus enumerated in the Notification dated 9th January 2014 for Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 will be the syllabus for the Competency Based Assessment Examination. Scheme of Examination: Scheme of examination of Competency Based Assessment will be strictly in accordance to the Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection) (Six Months Training) Rules, 2014 and Amendment Rules 2020- Schedule II. There will be Theory Assessment and Practical Assessment.

1. Theory assessment- **Minimum Pass Marks for Theory will be 50**

- a). 100 Marks –Two Hours
- b). 50 multiple choice questions of one mark each = 50 marks
- c). 10 short answers with five marks each= 50 marks. Short questions will have a defined space for candidates to fit answer.

2. Practical Assessment: **Minimum Pass Marks for Practical will be 60**

2.(a). **Practical Assessment Final Examination**(For candidates completing Six months training after 9th January 2014.

- a). 20 marks for Log book
- b). 50 marks for Demonstrations- Five Demonstrations of 10 marks each
- c). 30 marks for Viva- on 3 case situations

2.(b). **Practical Assessment Competency Based Assessment**(For candidates conducting ultrasound procedures in a Genetic Clinic or Ultrasound Clinic or Imaging Centre on basis of one year experience or Six Months Training from before 9th January 2014)

- a). 60 Marks for Demonstrations- Six Demonstrations of 10 marks each
- b). 40 Marks for Viva- on 4 case situations

Centers for Examination: The Theory and Practical Examination will be conducted by Pen and Paper/OMR mode at Government Medical Colleges – Jaipur, Ajmer, Udaipur, Jodhpur, Bikaner, Kota.

Result of the Examination: The Result of Theory and Practical Examination will be declared after completion of Practical Assessment at all centers on the RUHS website www.ruhsraj.org

Award of Certificate: The Certificate for qualifying the Competency Based Assessment will be issued by Director Medical Education and Countersigned by State Appropriate Authority, as mentioned in Pre-conception and Pre-natal Diagnostic Techniques (Prohibition of Sex Selection)(Six Months Training) Amendment Rules 2020.
